## 2011 Indian Pueblo Cultural Center Pueblo House Summer Camp

Summer vacation is just around the corner, and the Indian Pueblo Cultural Center is pleased to announce that it will offer two, two -week sessions of its celebrated summer day camp this year. Our first session is designed for students 6-9 years old and will take place Monday - Friday June 20 - July 1, 2011. Our second session is designed for students 10-12 years old and will take place Monday - Friday, July 11-22, 2011.

Each camp is an immersion based experience, exploring Pueblo culture, history, art, music, agriculture and cooking. Each session will feature workshops with world renowned Pueblo potters, painters, chefs and musicians. Campers will work in our newly expanded garden and living landscape with Pueblo farmers who are continuing the millennia old Pueblo agricultural tradition, and will learn from our dedicated Pueblo camp staff about the thousand year old Pueblo culture.

The last day of each session will be dedicated to the cooking of a Pueblo feast to which all campers' families are invited. Campers will work directly with Pueblo cooks to bake traditional bread and make the celebratory closing feast.

## 2011 Summer Day Camp Authorization for Medical Treatment

The Indian Pueblo Cultural Center wishes to avoid difficulties in obtaining medical services for children who may become ill or injured during the 2011 Summer Day Camp Program. As the parent/ guardian of a child participating in this program, it is necessary that you consent, in advance, to hospitalization, medical attention or surgery for your child in case an emergency occurs. If no consent is given, you must provide a written statement of procedures to be followed if your child is injured or becomes ill during the 2011 Summer Day Camp Program.

In the event of illness or injury, a reasonable effort will be made to contact you and designated emergency contacts to obtain consent in advance of medical services being administered. If we are unable to contact you, Indian Pueblo Cultural Center staff will consent to such services for your child by acting in your behalf based on written advanced authorization. That authorization is the consent form below.

I, the parent/ guardian of \_\_\_\_\_ have read the above and hereby designate Indian Pueblo Cultural Center staff to act on my behalf in the event of a medical emergency.
